Special Reports and New Business

Bushwacker Night Race Flyer - Please Check

Coyotes Pre Race - Jakes Valley, Ely, NV. June 21st. Race 1- 7:30 am, approximately 9.5 miles for 1 hour. Race 2- 9:30 am, 0.78 mile loop for 30 minutes. Race 3- 10:30 am, 0.78 mile loop for 40 minutes. Race 4- 12:15pm 37 miles, novice do one lap and all others do 2 laps. Raffle for adult and youth will start at 11:30 am, tickets are \$1 each or \$20 for 25. T-shirts for sale as well. We originally planned for a different location, then mid May BLM made us aware that we were not able to use the approved course, we had to come up with a new plan by May 30th. We hope everyone enjoys the race, thanks for all the support

Issues with future races:

SNDR- AMRA has dropped out of the joint race. SNDR will still host the race in Laughlin.

Jackrabbit Desert GP Discussion and possible vote. Race in Cedar City has to be postponed at its current location. New location and date set for November 22nd at Mesquite MX track, owner wants to promote offroad racing. It will be a GP with multiple laps, because of this the course would be less than 10 miles. 6-8 miles of prepped course, enduro section and turn areas included. Fees will be the same as they were on the previous flyer.. All classes will race and be trophied immediately. Example- 50+ class would all start together and race together but will be scored and trophies only based on their respective classes.

Coach- Will 50cc Novice all be trophied?

Klye- Yes. 50cc would all race together but be separated at scoring by class.

Susie- Would like to be present at sign-ups to ensure each rider is in the correct class as this has been an issue in past Jackrabbit races

Kyle - Yes we can set up a booth next to registration for MRAN.

Joe- Can we set up our scoring shoot to make sure MRAN riders go through?

Kye- Track owner was very against that, all riders will still have a transponder, it would be better to have one scoring system run by the promoter. Transponders will be available for free, if not returned there will be a charge.

Kody- The problem with not having our own scoring shoot is transferring the MRAN riders to our database. We need to have a separate scoring shoot so that results don't have to be hand entered post race, with each and every riders time. Only MRAN riders would ping on the scoring shoot

Kyle- Owner would be willing to provide a file with the results that MRAN could upload

Joe- Are there going to be Kurt Caselli markings on course?

Kyle - Yes, it is an AMA event. It was already a scheduled event, we're joining them

Susie - If JackRabbit's roster members are not working this race, club members would not be

receiving club points. They would need to volunteer at working a race, either Coyotes or one after to earn their club points, it's not fair otherwise

Kyle- If someone is chasing points they can work our race. Volunteers will be needed, club will be working the race flagging, ect.

Joe- As long as you can guarantee that your club members will be working the race it shouldn't be an issue

Kyle - Promoter is inviting all who want to compete to endorse offroad racing, turnout average was about 400 riders previously. Promoter is aware the MRAN requires \$10 a rider paid back

Coach- Once scoring has been imported, a list will be sent with MRAN riders only so MRAN can collect fees and dues. We need to figure out insurance, are you doing insurance through AMA or through MRAN?

Kyle- Yes it will be an AMA event. Gate Fee/wristband is \$15 and camping fee for the weekend is \$30 for the weekend.

Coach - Are Jackrabbits going to be racing this race?

Kyle- Anyone who's not chasing MRAN championship points won't be racing, but those who are not in points lead may race.

Darrel - Is there a chance to practice on the course before the race?

Kyle - Friday is open for practice

Susie - Not full course practice just the moto course, and there is a fee to ride it beforehand

Alex Krebs - There are two different 85 races, one super mini and one 85, how does that work?

Susie - It will be more broken down into respective races once a final flyer has been made.

Track prep/maintenance will happen between races

Joe - 50's will be their own course

Alex - As the day goes on the course is going to be hammered, how are kids going to ride a course that going to be way rougher than it was earlier in the day for other races?

Coach - Is there a way to make sure all MRAN mini riders, like the 85's are going to race in the same race? There are kids on 150's, 112's and 80's, all chasing championship points. Some kids will race earlier in the day and their competitors will race later in the day.

Kyle - I will make sure that it is a known concern, Gary wants to make things better for the rider

Coach - If we can make sure the mini's that are racing are all in the same race, this will also make it easier for scoring

Alex - MRAN 85's are one class as far as points

Susie - I will still split the riders into proper classes

Kyle - The key is to have all 85's race the same race correct?

Susie - As long as I can get results asap I can start breaking it down

Darrell - What are we expecting time wise for the big bikes

Kyle- 45-50 minutes, if you're an AA or expert it will be a 90 minute race.

Coach - I motion we add it to the schedule, the big concern is the 50's and 85's will all be together.

Kody - We still need to vote on this issue, there are many exceptions needed, and this isn't a desert race. There is sympathy that the Cedar location isn't possible, but this course does not meet the mile requirement at 6 miles. We need to table this motion, take the information back to our clubs and vote on this race being a part of the schedule.

Susie - If you're going to be a MRAN rider at this race we will not be doing day cards, they will need to sign up for a MRAN membership

Joe- They can come to the last race of the year, get a membership for that race and also have it carry over for the next year. Gary loves desert racing, he wants us there. He's wanted to include MRAN for many years to benefit the offroad racing community. If we ask him to make some concessions he should be able to do that. I think it's a great idea, but do agree we need to table

the vote till after we've all talked to our clubs. There are changes we'll have to make even though it's a GP format

Kyle - We can let everyone know the details and get it on the calendar, the date is coming up soon so we'd like to get it on the calendar now

Kody - We haven't had any information to take back to our clubs for this race, we need to go back to our clubs, present the details and come back and vote

Coach motions to table vote with the mentioned changes till next meeting in July, the biggest concern is still the mini's. Talk about the positive things, it's an extra race on the calendar, we'll figure out the mini's and next meeting we can vote, generate a flyer and if approved we can get moving

Dave Martin - Jackrabbits should not be allowed to race their own race. That could effect someone chasing points as well

Coach - Jackrabbits could be taken out of the points at results, because even if they're not chasing points, they could knock another rider out of their points position.

Susie - Anyone who isn't MRAN will not be on MRAN results, they will be separated and only MRAN members will be scored against other MRAN members

Dave - Jackrabbits are MRAN members, and they could effect the points of the other kids who are chasing points

Susie - If they are part of the hosting club they will not be included in the final results or gain points

Joe- The rule books states that in a desert race a club member cannot race it's race

Alex- SSTB runs two races, they race their GP but they also work a race, Jackrabbits is only doing one race so they shouldn't be able to race

Susie - If they race they will not be included in results or points, they will also not be trophied

Jarrod - Once the Jackrabbits are removed from the results, the riders behind them will be

moved up.

Kody - This is the desert series, even if they aren't getting points, they are another obstacle on the course that could affect other riders races and points

Dave - It also sets a precedent, Groundshakers do not allow their club to race its own race, and if they do, volunteers and help are lost.

Joe - Lets take it back to our clubs, get ready to vote at the next meeting

Radios- Please let us know after the Coyotes race if they worked well or if we have any issues

Trailer - Jarrod and Coach will figure out who will get the trailer to Ely.

SSTB race dates - April 11th 2026 race will have a Friday one lap pre-run, at a set time.

September 19th of 2026.

Gamblers race is set for January 24th, 2026

Groundshakers scheduled for May 2nd 2026

If clubs have dates for 2026 please bring them to the next meeting, Also there are no other series races on the Jackrabbits race date.
