### Voting on New Rules Changes:

- Race flyer submission and Competition Committee approval requirement:

Coach- All flyers need to be submitted to MRAN Competition Committee at least 90 days prior

to race, flyer must be approved before it's posted for advertising. If a club is late on flyer they will

be fined \$100 per week til; submission. We need to do more for the calendar, families need to

be able to plan.

Joe- Can we adjust to 60 days instead of 90?

Courtney - Sometimes BLM is not approving our final changes or mileage/course till a few weeks before the race

Coach- Changes can be made to flyers if needed

Joe- Can we create a "save the date" form so people have the basics to go off of, then an official

flyer can be posted with more precise info?

Darrell - We can add highlights to the social media pages to reduce redundant posts

Lance - 60 days is a good timeline, but the MRAN page needs improvement on getting info and

rider/bike switch. Riders may ride their own bike, but teams will be eligible for finisher pins only.

Entry fee of \$120

Coach - If there's an expert on the team they need to race as experts

Vote is tabled to provide clarification

- Eliminate the Classic and Revolution divisions and replace with Vintage division

Kody- this will reduce the amount of classes for MRAN, the new division will include any full-framed motorcycle that is 25 years older than the current year, and designated by the letter

H. This will boost participation by eliminating the restrictions of former divisions. This will be one

Kody- Clubs make too many trophies, many do not get picked up leading to boxes of leftover

trophies each year. It's difficult and time consuming to track down each rider who has not picked

up trophies. While following current suggested trophying percentages, we can add a change to

trophy up to the top 3 in each class per division.

Dave- We've had 30+ 50cc Novice riders, we're currently required to trophy 100% of that class

which becomes very costly.

Courtney- Can we change the rule to award 50% of the 50cc Novice class?

Joe- 50% seems reasonable

Kody- Rule will allow for 50% of 50cc Novice to be trophyed

Kody- Proposes to table vote till next month, this would allow Gary to speak on his proposed

rule change himself, as he was not present

Rule change tabled till next meeting

- Decrease AA Premier class payout

Kody- Clubs are losing money on the AA Premier division, proposing to reduce the payout to

50% of the \$100 entry fee. Currently they receive all but the MRAN per rider fee and BLM fee.

This would not affect the Women's AA class or any other potential AA class
