Treasurer: Michael Collins - MRAN Club Dues are still owed by the Jackrabbits for 2025 and 2026. MRAN Insurance has been paid to Leavitt Insurance. We have received and deposited the money from MINT 2025 in the amount of \$5,000 as agreed upon. Gamblers have been paid for their race. MRAN Banquet facility, taco truck, prizes, trophies and jackets are all paid. We like the current banquet location but if anyone has leads on a different place they'd like to use let MRAN know.

Desert Referee: Alex Krebs - 116 online sign ups, 157 total entries. One rider was bumped from 85cc nov, to 85cc am. In the future we need to make sure the start/finish is clear for the lineup of the next starting race.

Asst. Referee: Josh Tom- Getting MRAN cards done, over 100 MRAN cards completed at the banquet

Public Relations: Brittany Tom - Uploaded rider spotlight and race director video to socials, posted pics and videos people submitted to the drop box. All clubs are very excited to have Brittany on board and excited to see MRAN getting exposure, great job

Legislative Officer: Steve Paxton - Great job on last race, outstanding radio relay. Injured rider received help quickly. Nothing to report on legislative side

Scoring: Garrett Darr - Scoring went good. Big bikes got a little backed up. Club points are hand entered so it will take some time. Everyone who did one lap at the Gamblers race will get 50% points so that will be hand entered as well.

Secretary: Courtney Snodgrass- Everyone had a great time, thank you to everyone who helped get the injured rider help, great job Brittany on the socials.

Special Reports and New Business

Gamblers Post Race- Everything went well. Riders meeting had a hard time hearing, 115 big bikes total. 2 injuries, one broken collarbone, one concussion, both were assisted quickly. 1 disabled bike was assisted off the course. Thank you to everyone who supported

Jackrabbits Pre-Race- Trying to get pits further from the highway. Pay close attention to GPS directions. Race 1 at 7:30 85s and JR Women, Race 2 at 8:30 50 novice, Race 3 at 10:30 50 expert and amateur and 65 novice. Race 4 at 12:00, there will be two separate loops- 1st loop approx. 27 miles, 2nd loop 40 miles and more technical. If riders aren't meeting the time limit to finish loop 2 they'll be sent back to the pits with a DNF, due to safety and daylight.

Dave Martin- Novice only does 1 lap correct?

Kyle- Thinking of doing a 30 minute cut off from loop 1, if you come in over that after the leader you'll be cut off. Unless riders want to

Darrell- How are we doing sign ups for officers who are running number 1 plates for fees? Rule book says they are comped

Garrett- Sign up in person, spoke with UMORA to accommodate.

Kyle - Wasn't aware #1 plates or officers are comped. AMA wouldn't accept outside insurance, so due to the high cost of AMA insurance the fees are as is, per flyer.

Darkside Pre-race- Feb 28th in Goodsprings. Limited parking and camping. Race 1 at 7:30 6 mile loop for 60 minutes. Race 2 at 9 am, 50cc novice will do 2 mile loop for 30 minutes. Race 3 at 9:45 for 2 miles and 40 minutes. Race 4 at 11 big bikes AA and expert riders, Race 5 2:30 big bikes Amateur and Novice. Starting order determined by darkside results and online signups.
