Desert Referee: Alex Krebs - SSTB race was great, one issue with a rider jumping the start of the AA line, still bumping kids up as needed. Complaints about Jr. Womens, planning to separate the class and bump riders up where needed, may consider a rule change for 2027 Coach - Jr. Women can be bumped up out of the Jr class into Womens.

Krebs - Will keep an eye on it to be sure and make a fair decision, have talked with Josh Tom as well.

Asst. Referee: Josh Tom- Working with Krebs to move riders up, helping PR. Took MRAN trailer to Pahrump for the OHV day

Krebs- If anyone has gear that can be donated it would be greatly appreciated

Public Relations: Brittany Tom - New videos are posted from the last race. Looking for more people to do the rider spotlight if there are any suggestions

Legislative Officer: Steve Paxton - Last week there was a meeting with Nevada Offroad Association in Pahrump regarding future land use, Nevada Offroad is asking for more support, opinions and thoughts.

Scoring: Garrett Darr - Last race went well other than printer not working, definitely the biggest race of the year. Sold 13 Big Bike, 4 minor, and 30 day cards. Ordered more Nov and Am temp cards. Talked to Dirt Rider about new checks for the AA riders, including a check for the Vet AA class, and adding MRAN Sponsors to the check. New printer is needed so that'll be picked up this weekend, money has been transferred into MRAN account

Special Reports and New Business

SSTB post Race - 193 total bikes, 122 Big Bikes, 20 50 Novices, 22 PeeWee's and 29 mini's. One injured rider in the mini's race. Temp plates did not have numbers on all 3 plates, numbers are too small. There were riders who were bumped up at the lineup so their plates were not correct on the line, for example white backing on a pro line. We need to make sure the temp plates are correct and write numbers as big as we can. Yucca Chuckers and Camp Valley are in discussion, nothing more to report on that as of now. Finisher pins will be handed out at the Bushwacker race

Garrett - Thank you for the help Coach, will improve on temp plates

Coach- Garrett is doing a great job

Krebs- Many people are running the wrong backgrounds on temp plates, something that will be enforced at upcoming races.

Coach - We can make a social media post regarding tech inspection, must have same 3 numbers on all plates

Joe- We can use the backgrounds ect. shown on the website

Garrett- If not followed they could be penalized, issue will be enforced

Bushwacker Pre Race - April 18th, Race 1- Mini's start at 7:30 am, 9.5 mile loop, 3 laps with a GP finish. Race 2- 50 Novice starts at 9:30, racing a 1/3 mile loop for 30 mins with a GP finish. Race 3- 10:15 Peewee's racing a 1.5 Mile loop for 45 mins with a GP finish. Race 4- Starts at noon, novice does one lap, everyone else does 2 laps to finish, racing a 40 mile loop, alt gas approx. mile 19. Big bike course- first half is technical, second half is more open then back into the trees.

Garrett - We need more signup sheets for day of, and more youth and adult waivers
MRAN cards need to be shown or checked at signups

Dustin Tanguay- Too much confusion in the lines and location for signups and MRAN cards.

Garrett- Will come up with ideas on making that an easier process

Groundshaker Pre Race - May 2nd in Caliente. Race 1- 7:30 Mini's, 17 mile loop for 1 hour, alt gas approx mile 10. Race 2- 9:30 50 Novice, 1 mile for 30 mins. Race 3- 10:30 PeeWee's racing 1 mile for 45 mins. Race 4- 12 pm, all Big Bikes. Novice does one lap, everyone else does 2 laps. 43 mile loop, alt gas approx. mile 17. T shirts for sale at sign ups, gift bags for race 2 and 3

finishers. Riders meeting for race 1 and 4 at scoring then parade them down to the starting line. Tech will be at scoring, riders won't be able to come through to the start line unless they have a tech sticker. Camping and pits are very tight, some deep water crossings so please be aware. Encouraged to camp or get motel in town if possible due to limited space
